- Facilitate the preparation and implementation of the Chemical Hygiene Plan (CHP) in compliance with OSHA standards (29 CFR 1910.1450), including all required plan elements.
- Provide training to lab personnel pursuant to OSHA requirements.
- Provide information to lab personnel as required by the CHP.
- Participate in the annual district review of the CHP, as required.
- Other duties and responsibilities as required of the Chemical Hygiene Officer in accordance with OSHA requirements.
