Registration is now open for the 15th Annual Ocean State XC Invitational to be held on Friday September 23 for middle schools and on Saturday September 24 for High Schools at Goddard State Park, [1095 Ives Road, Warwick RI 02818](#).

The High school meet on average has over 3,500 participants representing over 200 high schools.

The middle school races for grades 6, 7, and 8 will be held on Friday, September 23 from 3:40 to 6:00. The middle school meet on average has over 1,600 participants from on average 50 schools.

Goddard Park is known for its rolling hills and scenic trail views overlooking the Greenwich Bay on its very spectator-friendly course. Ample room is available for warmup and team tents. Sanctions have been requested from CT, GA, MA, ME, NH, NJ, NY, PA, RI, and VT.
